

AFF live stream and video referee system requirements

- The tripod with video camera needs to set approximately 7 to 10 metres back from the finals piste located as close to the centre as possible.
- A table and chairs at this location for placing equipment on to have a control position for the systems.
- A dedicated 240v power feed at this location.
- A small table to place the video referee laptop on for review by the video referee and referee.
- For the live stream Audio a split of the D.T. announcement microphone to appear at the control position we travel with about 25 metres of extra microphone cable to try to accommodate this but ideally it would be delivered to the control position on a male XLR connector.
- Bollards and ropes as required to protect the control position and to keep spectators out of the camera shot.

- At Australian nationals or other competitions where the referee wears a microphone. Ideally an audio split of this microphone to be delivered to the control position on male XLR connector for the live stream audio. If this is not possible we travel a radio microphone for the referee and they will need to wear 2 microphones.
