To AFF Secretary General before 21 April 2006

The entry fee AUS \$100, EUR 60 or CHF 100 per fencer entered in Individual Grand Prix **is to be paid with the entry** (payable to AFF Inc). Any fencer not selected will have their entry fee refunded in full.

Starting from the deadline for the entries indicated on the FIE Web-site (15 days prior to the event) and, before the Tuesday preceding the competition, a fencer can be replaced by another one, but no additional entry can be registered. To do so, National Federations must send a written request of fencer's replacement to the FIE (by fax or e-mail). Should a fencer be injured, the rules for the World Championships are applicable.

Entries for Australia are restricted to 20 fencers, if more than 20 entries are received the 20 fencers will be selected from entered fencers based on AFF Open Rankings immediately after AFF#1 Open Women's Epee (April 23rd, 2006). A fencer may withdraw up before entries are submitted to the FIE May 10th, 2006 and be replaced by a reserve. If a selected fencer fails to present for the event the AFF will require payment of the fine levied (see below) by that fencer.

All Australian Fencers please note rules applicable to FIE GRAND Prix events:

Rule o.54 (partial text)

Confirmation of the presence of the fencers and teams is made at the time the fencers and teams are entered with the FIE.

Should a fencer or team who have been entered not present themselves to fence, their federation will be **penalised with a fine of 500 Euros/750 CHF**, payable to the FIE, except if the federation concerned has warned the organisers by the Tuesday preceding the competition at the latest.

Weapon Control: **At Venue from:** **09:00HRS – 10:30 HRS, Friday 26 May**
08:00HRS – 09:00 HRS, Saturday 27 May
08:30HRS – 10:00 HRS, Sunday 28 May

Rules/Licence: FIE rules apply and an **International Licence** must be held

Uniforms: Uniforms must carry: your national graphic as approved by the FIE, as well as athletes name and three letter national code.

Insurances: Fencers are reminded that travel, property and health insurances are **their own responsibility** and are strongly recommended.

Referees: Referees are appointed by the FIE

No late entries: The organisers of all official competitions must, at risk of a penalty of a fine of 1000 Euros/1500 CHF, refuse the entry of any fencers not appearing on lists conforming with the above, any entry not requested by a federation and any entry of either fencer or referee not in possession of an FIE licence valid for the current season.
