Entries:

Entry form (downloadable): must be sent to AFF Secretary General before 23 April 2007

Payment of Entries:

The entry fee AUS \$100 (NSW fencers) or \$60 (all other states' fencers) per fencer entered in Individual World Cup **is to be paid with the entry** (payable to AFF Inc). Fencers may withdraw by notifying the AFF Secretary General prior to May 1st, 2007 and entry fees will be refunded in full. Between the 1st and 10th May fencers may withdraw but will forfeit their entry fee except in cases of **properly authenticated injury**. From the 10th May 2007 there can be no further additional entries nor the withdrawal of a name except in cases of **properly authenticated injury** or 'force majeure'.

If a fencer notifies her withdrawal after May 11th or fails to present for the event the AFF will require payment by the fencer of the fine levied by the FIE (see below).

o.54 Entries by name for World Cup competitions (partial text)

Confirmation of the presence of the fencers is made with the entering of the fencers with the organisers.

Should a fencer who has been entered not present himself to fence, her federation will be penalised with a fine of 500 Euros/750 CHF, payable to the FIE, except in cases of properly authenticated injury or 'force majeure'.

Selection: Entries for Australia are restricted to 30 fencers (plus the number to make up even pools of 7). If more than 30 entries are received the 30 fencers will be selected from entered fencers based on AFF Open Rankings immediately after AFF#1 Open Women's Epee (April 22nd, 2007). Any fencers entered beyond the 30 fencers selected will become reserves to replace fencers who withdraw before May 10th or to make up even pools of 7 (this will be a last minute decision made on Wednesday May 23rd).

Weapon Control: At Venue from: 11:00 hrs – 12:45 hrs, Saturday 26 May
07:30 hrs – 08:15 hrs, Sunday 27 May

Rules/Licence: FIE rules apply and an International Licence must be held

Uniforms: Uniforms must carry: your national graphic as approved by the FIE, as well as athletes name and three letter national code.

Insurances: Fencers are reminded that travel, property and health insurances are **their own responsibility** and are strongly recommended.

Hotels: **The Australian Fencing Federation has negotiated a special arrangement (47% off rack rate) with Accor Hotels. Two Accor Hotels are located at Sydney Olympic Park.** These are within 400m of the competition venue. There are a total seventeen Accor hotels in Sydney, *(So you could stay in the city (or anywhere in Australia), before or after the World Cup and stay at SOP just for the event – all at the event rate!)*
