

COVID-19 COMPETITION POLICY

1. APPLICATION

- 1.1. This policy is in effect from 15 February 2021 until further notice.
- 1.2. This policy takes precedence over any conflicting provisions relating to national competitions, including but not limited to the Selection Policy and Competition Policy.

2. RANKING POINTS

2.1. Ranking points will accrue for all national fencing events as provided for in the Selection Policy notwithstanding there may be **government travel restrictions** in place which prevent some residents entering the host city at the time of the event.

3. CANCELLATION

- 3.1. The AFF may, at its absolute discretion, cancel any national competition where:
 - a) it considers the health and safety of athletes and officials to be at risk; or
 - b) based on state and territory COVID-19 public health advice; or
 - c) where **government travel restrictions** are imposed affecting sufficient athletes and officials as to render the tournament unviable.

4. EXPENSES

- 4.1. Athletes travel at their own financial risk. The AFF accepts no responsibility for athlete expenses incurred through **government travel restrictions**.
- 4.2. Notwithstanding section 4.1, the AFF will refund entry fees upon request for athletes affected by **government travel restrictions** imposed on a location where the athlete ordinarily resides, where the travel restriction arises after they have entered a national event and up to 24 hours prior to the first event in which they are entered.

5. ADHERANCE TO COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

- 5.1. Athletes and officials will keep up-to-date and adhere to all respective host-city state/territory and/or local public health authorities COVID-19 restrictions.
- 5.2. Tournament organisers will assist to the best of their abilities to keep participants up-to-date.
- 5.3. All athletes and officials will maintain awareness of any evolving COVID-19 environment in their home state and align their actions with informed decisions. The Covid-19 environment can be rapidly evolving.
- 5.4. All regulations related to spectators will be determined by respective host-city state/territory and/or local public health authorities.

6. **DEFINITIONS**

In this Policy, unless the context requires otherwise, these words mean:

Government travel restrictions means restrictions published on any Australian state government website which affect free movement of people.

Home state means the state in which a person ordinarily resides.

Ordinarily reside means the address listed for an affected athlete in the AFF Member Portal.
