

AUSTRALIAN FENCING FEDERATION ESTABLISHES HIGH PERFORMANCE COMMISSION













The AFF is focused on supporting athletes to be the best they can be. With a clear aim on the upcoming Asian and World Championships, and the Olympics of 2024, 2028, and likely Brisbane in 2032, the AFF has established a High Performance Commission (HPC) to optimise and support athlete development.

The High Performance Commission will establish a high performance pathway from developing youth through senior elite athletes and will be responsible for overseeing policy formation and management for areas that can impact and enhance performance - in selection, coaching, refereeing, competition format, the High Performance Program and its Performance Pathways, resourcing, and a range of other initiatives.

The HPC will shortly open registrations for joining the National Squad in each category and weapon.
